Notes on the Competition & Banquet:

- All contestants must check in to receive information, shirt, and schedule for the weekend.
- EACH contestant must have a completed & signed registration form (and be paid in full) on file in order to compete regardless of who pays for fees.
- The schedule will be tight so we ask that all contestants be ready to go at their appointed times.
- If you will be using a propane forge, make sure your tank is FULL. Kremmling has limited locations for filling empty tanks.
- If you are unable to bring an auction item, contestants must pay the additional \$40.
- All contestants will be asked to sign the fairground policy and photo release upon check in.
- Division I contestants are allowed a striker for the Class competition. All Division I contestants entered into the Live Shoeing *must* have a striker.
- Banquet will begin at 6:30PM. Station tear down can take place prior to banquet.
